6 Things Bitterness Will Do to Your Life:

1. Bitterness will devastate you spiritually.

"But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness and self control." Galatians 5:22 NIV

"Don't be misled: No one makes a fool of God. What a person plants, he will harvest. The person who plants selfishness, ignoring the needs of others—ignoring God!—harvests a crop of weeds.
